## EXECUTIVE SUMMARY AND CAREER ACHIEVEMENTS

### • **Integrated Infrastructure Development**

- As Chairman (INCAP), led the public Private Partnership (PPP) projects across AP and formulated key infrastructure policies and regulations to facilitate large scale private sector investments in GoAP's infrastructure
- Through INCAP, led development of municipal services, roads, ports, inland waterways, transport terminals, inland ports, energy storage transmission and distribution including gas infrastructure

### • **Industrial Development and Promotion**

- Formulated the new Industrial Policy 2020-23, facilitating a 'risk-free' investment-friendly environment for setting up of industries and minimize the impact on the environment
- Led development of industrial infrastructure in over 300 industrial parks in AP and Implemented industrial parks exclusively for special category (SC/ST/BC) and minority communities
- Successfully organized the Partnership Summit 2012. The Summit has witnessed Andhra Pradesh Signing of 243 MoUs Worth Rs 6,49,432.38 Crore and providing employment to 678597 people, which is highest for this kind of programme.
- Instrumental in organizing Bio Asia 2011 and 2012, the Global Bio Business Forum, were held from February 21-24, 2011 and February 8-10, 2012 and attracted 2500 delegates & visitors from 38 countries, including overseas participation of 121 with sizeable delegations from China (11), France (9), Germany (9), Iran (26), Malaysia (14), USA (10), Ukraine (4), Belarus (4), etc.
